

DALLAS COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE REFRESH

CHALLENGE

Dallas College made the decision to refresh its Technology Infrastructure so that the six (6) colleges are positioned to take advantage of solutions that will improve services for students both from an academic and physical security perspective.

ACTION

Dallas College engaged Novom to perform infrastructure design, support, the procurement process, and manage all aspects of the Technology Refresh.

The Novom team was key in developing the overall two-year deployment schedule that included cable infrastructure, Backbone fiber ring, network, telephony, security, and construction coordination.

The backbone fiber ring interconnects each of the 155 IDF closets to the Data Center within each college. The design consists of a campus ring that delivers diverse paths from the IDF network switches to each campus core network.
